SCOUTING WEEKEND OVERNIGHT CAMPER INFORMATION

September 7th, 2019

- Please sign in at the Corn Maze admission barn located at the Corn Maze when you arrive. You will receive your camp site location when you sign in.
- The campsites are marked by flags around the parking lot next to the corn fields. We ask that if you wish to have a fire in your campsite that you use a fire pan to prevent scarring of the grass in our parking lot. You can also choose to reserve a campfire site on our website at <https://jonamacorchard.com/camp-fire/> These sites are \$40 and come with benches, a counter for food, wood, a fire ring, and are located in the shade.
- There are port-a-potties and hand wash stations are located near the campsites. Water is available from the hydrant in the shelter house near the Concession Trailer. Please note that we will close the gates to the orchard area after dark. Only adults may cross the gates if water or other items are needed.
- The Country Store and Bakery, as well as all outside activities close at 5:30 PM on Saturday, only the Corn Maze will remain open after that time.
- Nighttime hayrides around the orchard will run from 8:30 to 9:30 PM free of charge.
- The parking lot lights and corn maze will be shut down at 9:30 PM and quiet time will begin. We ask that adult leaders keep scouts in their tents and campsites after that time.
- Attendees will need to purchase wrist bands for the corn maze and barn yard admission; the discounted cost is \$5.00 per person. These will be good for both Saturday and Sunday.

Our designated emergency storm shelter is located inside our Cider House or Store and Bakery. In the event of severe storms requiring shelter, we will notify the adult leaders and provide access to the storm shelters.
- Troop #33 from DeKalb will offer a pancake breakfast from 7:00 to 9:00 AM Sunday morning, cost is \$5 per person. All proceeds go directly to Troop #33

- Please leave your campsite area clean; garbage cans will be available for any litter.
